On behalf of Climate Action Campaign, I write to you today to support the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System's (MTS) application submitted under the FTA's Areas of Persistent Poverty Program.

MTS has recently approved a plan to convert its entire bus fleet to a fully zero emission fleet by 2040. In order to accommodate and maintain a fully zero emission bus (ZEB) fleet, MTS must upgrade each bus division with the required infrastructure in order to maintain and operate ZEBs.
